What is the Master of Real Estate® Designation?

Members who have earned their specialist designations continue to attend courses and seminars throughout their professional lives can now receive a special “tip of the hat” to recognize their dedication to lifelong learning. The Master of Real Estate® designation and pin will honor their efforts and make their commitment to ongoing professional development more visible to their fellow REALTORS® and members of the public as well.

What are the requirements for the MRE Designation?

Before taking classes that apply to the MRE, you must hold both the GRI and at least one other NAR-family related designation. The following designations qualify you to begin working toward the MRE Designation:

ABR	Buyer representation
ALC	Farm and land
CCIM	Commercial investment
CIPS	International real estate
CPM	Property management
CRB	Brokerage management
CRE	Real estate counseling
CRS	Residential sales
GAA/RAA	Appraisal
GREEN	NAR's GREEN Designation
PMN	Performance Management Network
SIOR	Industrial, office
SRES	Senior Real Estate Specialist

How do I get started?

Once you have your GRI and another NAR-family related designation, you simply complete a total of three courses, chosen from the following categories, within a two-year period. The two-year period begins with the date of the first course you take. One of the courses must be from Category 1, and no more than two may come from any single category:

Category 1	GRI modules (All MO courses qualify. These are numbered from 401 to 412) (OR) Additional Missouri GRI Master level series classes as approved by MAR Education Committee (Note: classes may be added if approved by MAR Education Committee)
Category 2	NAR-family related designation courses (OR) NAR-family related certification courses
Category 3	REBAC elective courses <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • “Generation Buy” • “HAFA Short Sales” • “Real Estate Marketing Reboot” • “Short Sales and Foreclosure Course” • “Successful Buyer Representation in New-Home Sales” • “Successful Buyer Representation in Relocation”
Category 4	At Home with Diversity: One America Course
Category 5	e-PRO (NAR's e-PRO Certification)
Category 6	MAR Business Conference Education classes Combination of two 3-hour Professional Development classes held during the conference (CE classes do not count) This category may include Property Management, Appraisal, or other affiliate group one-day education classes held during the conference.
Category 7	Missouri GRI Graduate Seminar —“Gratitude”
Category 8	MAR Annual Professional Standards Seminar
Category 9	SRS (Seller Representative Specialist) Designation Course Conferred by SRS Council, LLP

“Complete” means that you pass the course test, if there is one. Submit your “pass” letter/certificate as documentation.

Where can I find schedules for applicable classes?

MAR's web site www.missourirealtor.org, and www.realtor.org contain postings of current courses as soon as dates are available. (Courses are subject to change.)



For how long is the MRE Designation valid?

Your designation will be valid through December 31 of the year two years after you earn it. For example, anyone who earns the MRE during 2011 will be entitled to use it through December 31, 2013.

Is the MRE Designation like other Designations?

Yes. Just like other designations, the MRE letters may be placed behind your name. The MRE designation is recognition of an achievement that must be updated periodically. The designation is valid until December 31 of the year two years after it is awarded. You must complete another three approved courses and remit the \$25 designation fee every two years to keep your designation valid. The MRE is a Missouri Association of REALTORS® state-sponsored designation and is not affiliated with or endorsed by NAR.
